Guidelines for Nomination

1. Each TESA affiliate may submit one (1) yearbook entry. Entries will only be accepted from current year affiliates (August 1 - July 31). Only yearbooks submitted with the official TESA form will be considered.

Your yearbook is published once a year and may include the following (not inclusive) suggested items.

- Lists of Officers
- Committee Members
- Association Members
- Theme
- Calendar of the year
- Association Bylaws
- Association Philosophy
- Notice of Meetings
- 2. Five (5) copies of the entry must be submitted.
- 3. Entries must be postmarked by February 25. Entries postmarked after that date will not be considered for judging.

- 5. The candidates and the sponsoring association will be notified following the judges decision.

Eligibility

- 1. Entry must be duplicate of one actually distributed to association membership.
- 2. Entries will only be accepted from current year affiliates.
